Not just a flight plan but an adventure

Adventure title: Finding the Rock

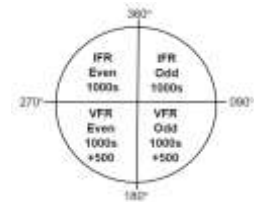
Preamble:

Ayers Rock (Uluru) known as the Rock, is in the Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park in the desert of central Australia. It is south-west of the town of Alice Springs in the Northern Territory. The challenge of this adventure flight is to find the Rock without using onboard radionav aids or the GPS.

Flight settings:

Platform: FSX & FSX Steam Edition

- Departure airport: Alice Springs (YBAS) Northern Territory, Australia
- Time & Season: Your discretion
- Weather theme: Your discretion
- Distance 180 nm
- Flight time: approx. 1hr 30 min
- Aircraft type: GA light to medium aircraft, single or twin prop.



Plan narrative

- Taxi to and takeoff RWY 30 (296°)
- Crossing the AS VOR (1.5 nm) turn left and track 236° outbound radial direct to Connellan Airport
- Climb and maintain 6500 feet.
- If you happen to get lost, tune the Ayers Rock Airport NDB 233 (AYE) & the AYE DME 117.1 and track it inbound.
- With Ayers Rock Airport in sight, descend to 4500 feet
- Over Connellan Airport, turn left HDG 057° and find the Rock.
- Do a left turning circuit of the Rock
- On completion of the circuit, continue due west to the distant Mt Olga Range
- Complete a left turning circuit of Mt Olga, then north-east back towards Ayers Rock Airport
- You can either land and complete the adventure here or return on the back course 056° direct to Alice Springs. Return altitude 7500 feet (or odd thousands + 500 feet)
